RE: Infection Control Updates

This communication will be in a slightly different format today to offer you a change.

Recreation News:

- We will not be offering any video calls on Memorial Day.
- Outside activities have increased.
 - Health Care residents are enjoying the expanded balcony and there is enough space for 3 residents at a time with social distancing.
 - Memory Support residents are using the courtyard in small groups for social distancing, usually four with a staff person.
 - Assisted Living residents are utilizing the C Wing courtyard independently in addition to any programs, chairs are arranged for social distancing.
 - Residents are taking advantage of walking “laps” around the courtyard and walking through the halls outside of mealtime.
 - In addition to sidewalk chalk art, residents have enjoyed seeing spontaneous bubbles floating past their windows. We have been staging bubble makers across the campus.

Laundry Services:

- We continue to be required to provide laundry services for all residents as part of the infection prevention/control plan.
 - We are not able to accommodate special requests for laundry settings, detergent preferences or softener preferences.
 - Ironing services are not available.
 - There is no charge for this service at this time.
 - Cleaning chemicals, water temperatures, and dryer settings are set per industry standards for infection prevention/control.

Sidewalk Visits:

- Family and friends need to remain on the sidewalk farthest from the building when “visiting” residents at this time.
- Guests should not be using any walkway that goes to a door or gated area.
- You may create your own sidewalk chart art when you visit; please bring your own chalk.
