RE: Updates

Our COVID Update: We have no new or active cases of COVID-19 in Manor East. We have no clusters of individuals with respiratory symptoms. Historically, we have had only one employee on health care test positive for COVID-19 and one employee on assisted living test positive for COVID-19. Both individuals have since recovered, are symptom free, and have returned to work.

Virginia Health Department (VDH) Update: VDH Guidelines were released Friday afternoon; <https://www.vdh.virginia.gov/content/uploads/sites/182/2020/06/VDH-Nursing-Home-Guidance-for-Phased-Reopening-6.18.2020.pdf>. We have submitted our request to transition to Phase I. Please note that until we have Local Health Department (LHD) approval, we must maintain all current protocols.

What will Phase I mean for Manor East? Any residents not on isolation or exhibiting cold symptoms, will be permitted to have meals in the dining room; 1 resident per table and 6-foot distancing maintained. Small group programs will be initiated with the same restrictions as dining.

Visitation on Campus: While in-facility visitation is still prohibited, the LHD is supportive of our “visitation screen” for outdoor use. The “screen” is made of plexiglass to provide a protective, cleanable, barrier. The specifics will be sent in a separate memo when we are able to start taking reservations for visits. It is important to note that extensive infection control measures will be in place and there will be limitations on visit availability.

Google Duo Calls: We will not be offering any video calls on Friday, July 3rd, in observance of the July 4th holiday. As always, all requests need to be made by Friday at noon the week prior to the intended call.
