RE: Updates

Labor Day Changes:

Recognizing the upcoming holiday, we will have a couple of changes. Our memos next week will be distributed on Tuesday Sept 1 and Thursday Sept 3. The next SignUp Genius link will go out on Tuesday, Sept 8.

The Current Normal:

We continue to offer programming within the guidelines of the Local Health Department and regulatory bodies. We were able to re-introduce professional haircare and will expand our outside visits next week. A recap of protocols in place:

- Residents are strongly encouraged/assisted to wear a face covering when out-of-room or when in-room and staff is providing care.
- Seating is limited to one person per table in the dining rooms and tables are spaced for social distancing.
- Group programs must provide for social distancing and provide for individual use of equipment.
- Visits are limited to the outside visit program or as allowed for compassionate care; using SignUp Genius or contacting the Resident Services representative.
 - These approved visitors must provide and wear a mask at all times when on campus.
 - Visitor must satisfactorily complete a COVID-19 screening.
- Staff assist with Google Duo calls when scheduled with Lauren Marwitz.
- Covenant Woods provides commercial laundry service for all residents at no cost. Per current pandemic guidelines, all laundry must be done in the facility's commercial laundry process.
- Deliveries for residents can be arranged with the Resident Services representative.
- The USPS delivers all mail to the Concierge and staff delivers to the assisted living in-house mailboxes to directly to the resident on health care and in memory support.

Our COVID Update:

We have no new or active cases of COVID-19 in Manor East. We have no clusters of individuals with respiratory symptoms. Historically, we have had only one employee on health care test positive for COVID-19 in May and one employee on assisted living test positive for COVID-19 in May. Both individuals have since recovered, are symptom free, and have returned to work.

Historically, we have had only two employees in independent living test positive for COVID-19, both in July. We have also had one independent living resident test positive for COVID-19, who has since recovered. None of the independent living cases have an impact on Manor East.
