RE: Updates

Positivity Rates:

The state positivity rate is currently at 12.5% and Hanover County is at 14.2%. While we are encouraged to see the rates beginning to come down, at present there are no changes in our visitation plan (see Current Visitation Plan below).

Vaccination Update:

We are set to provide residents with their second dose of the vaccine next week. Any resident who was unable to receive their first dose earlier this month has been provided an opportunity to receive their first dose next week. They will then get their second dose in late February.

Responsible Party Notifications:

In situations when we find it necessary to place an entire wing or floor on isolation as a precautionary measure, we will use the SARA messaging system to get that notice out to the responsible parties. This will provide a very quick notification. Should a resident require additional safety measures unique to their situation, the responsible party will also receive a personal call. As per usual, we will continue to provide additional information in the weekly memo or via a special memo, whichever is most appropriate. Calls will be sent to the phone number you provided when registering for the SARA call messages. Current Visitation Plan:

Google Duo calls are available to residents. To allow every resident assisted access to these visits we are scheduling one call weekly. If a resident is on isolation, the calls will be coordinated directly with Lafon Kinchen, RN, Infection Control Preventionist at 804-569-8093. Otherwise, calls for assisted living and health care residents who are not on isolation are coordinated with Lauren Marwitz, Recreation Manager at 804-569-8713 and calls for Memory Support are coordinated with Tara Beatty, AL Social Services Coordinator at 804-417-9134. Compassionate care visits are provided under separate criteria. Questions should be directed to your Resident Services representative. At this time, a resident or visitor's vaccination status does not change the plan.

Planning for the Future:

As of today, we have not received any information on when current infection control measures may change. Even those who are fully vaccinated are still advised to follow all infection control measures currently in place for everyone, and especially in long-term care communities, which include wearing a mask when others are present, maintaining at least 6-foot social distancing, and following isolation protocols.
