RE: Updates

Positivity Rates:

The Hanover county positivity rate has dropped to 10.9% this week. We are still monitoring isolation needs of residents as well as test results on campus and in-person visits are still suspended except for compassionate care.

Vaccine Update:

This week marks the second round of vaccinations for many residents and staff. Individual immunity levels are achieved seven (7) days after the second dose. Residents and staff who received their first dose this week will get their second dose the week of February 25.

Being fully vaccinated does not mean there will be reduced restrictions. The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Virginia Health Department (VDH) have stressed that all prevention measures that have been implemented will be continued. This means visitation policies will follow the same process and isolation measures will remain the same for all individuals, whether fully vaccinated, partially vaccinated, or not vaccinated.

Vaccination status falls in the health privacy category. While an individual may share their vaccination status with anyone they choose, Covenant Woods will not identify specific individuals (residents, staff, or vendors) by their vaccination status.

Visitation Plan:

Google Duo calls are available to residents. To allow every resident assisted access to these visits we are scheduling one call weekly. Calls for assisted living and health care residents are coordinated with Lauren Marwitz, Recreation Manager at 804-569-8713 and calls for Memory Support are coordinated with Tara Beatty, AL Social Services Coordinator at 804-417-9134. Compassionate care visits are provided under separate criteria. Questions should be directed to your Resident Services representative. A resident or visitor's vaccination status does not change the plan.

Planning for the Future:

As previously mentioned, infection control measures will not be loosened in the immediate future. We will continue to work with the Local Health Department (LHD) regarding our outbreak status and how that will affect in-person visits and admissions.

Notifications:

When we need to make changes (like isolation) that affect a group of residents, we will use the SARA phone messaging system.

When there is a change in a single resident's status (like isolation) we will call the responsible party directly.

Current COVID Status:

Cumulatively, since the beginning of the pandemic, the total number of people, that have tested positive for COVID-19, are listed in the chart below.
