RE: Updates

It has been so good to see residents going off-site with family and having in-room visit options in addition to the assisted visits and calls. So many happy faces on campus. We are working behind the scenes to reduce any wait time for visitors when waiting for an escort to the resident's room. With the current infection control guidelines, the escort is necessary, and we appreciate your patience.

We anticipate additional governmental recommendations over the next several weeks and will continue to keep you informed on how they will affect visitation on campus. Our plans for a Spring Family Meal are planned for the week of April 19th. As of this memo, we are still under gathering restrictions and a differentiation between vaccinated resident visits and non-vaccinated resident visits. To be considered "vaccinated", one must be two weeks past their second dose of vaccine if getting a two-step vaccine, or two weeks past their vaccination if receiving a single dose vaccine.

Based on the current guidance from the CDC, CMS, and VHD (abbreviation definitions can be found on page 2 of this memo) we plan to offer the following a combination of seated dining and outside visitation:

Seated Dining (Vaccinated Residents Only):

- Mealtimes will be scheduled providing two service times for lunch and for dinner.
- Residents will be able to have up to two guests.
- Memory Support residents will dine on their unit either Monday or Tuesday that week.
- All other residents will dine on Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday of that week.
- Rapid/POC testing will be available for guests upon request.

Outdoor Visits (Non-Vaccinated Residents Only):

- Hour long visits will be scheduled on Tuesday, April 20.
- Residents may have up to two guests.

A menu and information on reservations will be sent to residents and their responsible party later this month. All information listed above is based on current guidelines, county positivity rates, and no identified positive COVID-19 cases.

Current Visitation Plan:

A complete explanation of our visit opportunities and information on how to arrange are provided to all new residents and families upon admission, posted on our website, and available upon request.

Vaccinated Residents:

- Daily visits by a single guest in the resident's room.
- A single assisted outdoor visit or Google Duo call each week.
- Visits outside or off campus without an automatic quarantine upon return.
- Compassionate care visits.

Non-Vaccinated Residents:

- A single assisted outdoor visit or Google Duo call each week.
- Compassionate care visits.
- Off campus visits with a quarantine period upon return.

All visitors will be provided a rapid/POC COVID test upon request. Questions about visitation options for residents in health care should be directed to Lauren Duval, Social Worker at 804-569-4208.
