RE: Updates

The Hanover County positivity rate is currently 8.1%. We intend to have our Spring Meal next week as planned. A reminder about the arrival process and infection control measures will be sent to the person who made the registration.

Current Visitation Plan:

Our visitation plan is designed around the prevalence of infection in our local area as well as the campus. CDC has specific guidelines based on positivity rates and any new identified cases. Additionally, the CDC provides infection control guidelines exclusive of infection or vaccination status.

A complete explanation of our visit opportunities and information on how to arrange are provided to all new residents and families, posted on our website, and available upon request. As mentioned last week, anyone taking residents off campus will sign an attestation form that outlines infection control guidelines per the CDC. Residents and the person taking them will be asked questions to allow staff to determine the level of potential exposure to respond according to guidelines for the safety of all.

Vaccinated Residents:

- Daily visits by a single guest in the resident's room (one visitor per day).
- A single assisted outdoor visit or Google Duo call each week.
- Visits outside or off campus without an automatic quarantine upon return.
- Compassionate care visits.

Non-Vaccinated Residents:

- A single assisted outdoor visit or Google Duo call each week.
- Compassionate care visits.
- Off campus visits with a quarantine period upon return.

All visitors will be provided a rapid/POC COVID test upon request. Questions about visitation options for residents in healthcare should be directed to Lauren Duval, Social Worker at 804-569-4208. Questions about visitation options for assisted living residents should be directed to Tara Beatty, AL Social Services Coordinator at 804-417-9134.

Screening access for daily visitors is provided at the main screening station on Brooks Farm Road, daily from 10am to 6:30pm. Compassionate care visitor screening is provided at the Brooks Farm Road entrance Monday- Friday from 6:30am-7pm, and on the weekends from 9am-7pm. Compassionate care visitors should enter at the main gate when the screening station is closed.

Planning for the Future:

Should the county positivity rate remain below 10%, we are working with the LHD and our Medical Director to prepare for reduced restrictions as visitors participate in safe infection control practices. Until more guidance is released from the CDC any change will be limited.
